#### 6. <u>Approval Of Minutes Of Previous Meeting(s)</u>

### 7. Update on Police Department Activity

Chief Gary Fountain was absent and Mayor Hughes gave the update on the police department's activity for the month of September. Activity included: cases filed 47; 5 felony arrests; 13 misdemeanor arrests; 3 assist other agencies; 74 responses on calls for service; 1 juvenile case; 2 auto accident response/report; 72 citations; and 113 warnings

# 9. <u>Tracy Cox – Update On Main Street Program</u>

Main Street Manager Tracy Cox gave an update on the Main Street Program. Activity for the month of September included committee meetings of the Advisory Boards; City Council meeting; Commissioners Court meeting; held Autumn Job Fair; clean-up and decorate downtown; and attended THC Mission Dolores Ribbon Cutting and Luncheon. # 11. <u>Discussion and Action If Any To Pass Resolution #10182016-1 To Authorize The San</u> <u>Augustine Chamber of Commerce Sassafras Festival And Have The Mayor To Sign A Street</u> <u>Closure Agreement With TxDOT</u>

Alderman Fussell offered the motion to adopt Resolution #10182016-1 authorizing Sassafras Festival and authorizing the Mayor to sign Street Closure Agreement with TxDot. Alderman Malone seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were Alderman Malone, Alderwoman Cabriales, and Alderman Fussell. Motion carried.

# 12. <u>Discussion And Action If Any To Approve Communities Unlimited To Be Engaged On City's</u> Behalf To Perform Rate Analysis For Submittal To A USDA Grant

Lanny Buck with KSA Engineers discussed the above item with the council. A rate study is necessary to demonstrate the amount of money our rate payers can bare to improve the sewer system. Alderman Malone offered the motion to approve the request to engage Communities Unlimited to USDA on City's behalf to perform rate analysis for submittal to a USDA grant. Alderman Fussell seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were Alderman Malone, Alderwoman Cabriales, and Alderman Fussell. Motion carried.

# 13. <u>Discussion and Action If Any To Award Bid(s) For The 2015 CDBG Grant For Water</u> <u>Plant Improvements</u>

Bids were received on September 30, 2016 on the above referenced project with three contractors submitting: (1) Cox Contractors, Nacogdoches, TX - \$193,524.00; (2) Don Langston Construction, Lufkin, TX - \$260,656.00; and (3) Duplichain Contractors, LLC, Alto, TX - \$277,100.00. Alderman Malone offered the motion to award the bid for the 2015 CDBG Grant for Water Plant Improvements to Cox Construction. Alderman Fussell seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were Alderman Malone, Alderwoman Cabriales, and Alderman Fussell. Motion carried.

# 14. <u>Discussion and Action If Any To Award Bid(s) For The Main Street Sidewalk Improvements</u> <u>Grant</u>

Bids were opened on Friday, October 7, 2016 on the above referenced project. One bid was received from Horton Excavating - \$147,194.00. Alderman Malone offered the motion to award the bid for the Texas Capital Fund Main Street Improvement Grant from the lone bidder Horton Construction with the removal of trash cans and lighting. Alderwoman Cabriales seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were Alderman Malone, Alderwoman Cabriales, and Alderman Fussell. Motion carried.

## 15. <u>Discussion Only To Hear From Art and Loretta Bedford Concerning Rates For Utilities For</u> <u>Unoccupied Buildings</u>

Art and Loretta Bedford presented a proposal to the City Council to change the policy regulating utilities for unoccupied dwellings within the City of San Augustine. They proposed that when status of the property changes to vacancy, the owner submits an application requesting no water, sewer, or garbage use. The City would then check the address to ascertain that the dwelling is empty and halt those services. No action was taken on this item as it was discussion only.
