### 5. Public Hearing On Texas Department Of Agriculture Main Street Program Grant

Mayor Hughes opened the public hearing on Texas Department Of Agriculture Main Street Program Grant. Mr. Bill Hoppee, Raymond K. Vann & Associates opened the floor for questions for the public hearing. The purpose of the public hearing was to announce to the citizens of the City of San Augustine that the City has expressed an interest in applying for a Community Development Block Grant. There were no questions or activity. The public hearing was closed.

### 8. <u>Update On Police Department Activity</u>

Officer Cameron Nichols presented an update on the police department's activity for the month of July. Activity included: cases filed 29; 3 felony arrests; 8 misdemeanor arrests; 10

assist other agencies; 146 responses on calls for service; 0 juvenile case; 2 auto accident response/report; 63 citations; and 36 warnings.

### 9. <u>Judge Betty Loggins – Update On Municipal Court Activity</u>

Judge Loggins was absent and Mayor Hughes reported 56 citations and collections of \$2685.40 for the month of July.

### 10. <u>Update On Main Street Program</u>

Main Street Manager Tracy Cox gave an update on the Main Street Program. Activity for the month of July included committee meetings of the Advisory Board and promotion committee meetings; approval has been obtained from the Commissioner's Court to have a junk in the trunk event starting November 1; two reinvestment grants have been given out by Main Street; plans are being made to help the Chamber of Commerce with the Sassafras Festival; dinner and movie night at Museum Theater scheduled for October 11, 2014; and working on Texas Capital Fund Main Street Grant.

### 11. <u>Discussion and Action To Approve Resolution Approving An Application For Funding Through The Texas Department Of Agriculture Main Street Program</u>

Mr. Bill Hoppe asked the council to approve the submission of an application by Main Street for funding through the Texas Department of Agriculture Main Street Program in the amount of \$150,000.00 with the City's match of \$45,000.00. The purpose of the grant is for sidewalk improvements in the City of San Augustine Main Street area at the intersection of Columbia Street and Broadway Street extending south from the intersection approximately two hundred linear feet along Broadway Street. The City's revolving line of credit will terminate on August 31, 2014 and action is needed for renewal. Alderman Malone offered the motion to grant authorization to City Manager Bruce Milstead to renew the revolving line of credit with BBVA Compass Bank in the amount of \$150,000.00 to pay utilities and other short time expenses. ### 20. <u>Discussion and Action To Approve 2014 Property Tax Rate And To Schedule Two Public Hearings If Necessary</u>
