5. <u>Discussion and Action If Any To Approve Sanitary Sewer Line Abandonment And</u> Quitclaim Ordinance

The council was given an ordinance finding that the portion of an existing sanitary sewer line located within the City of San Augustine, Texas, has been relocated and is not necessary for public use, providing for the vacation, abandonment, quitclaim, and closure of that portion of such sanitary sewer line; and releasing and quitclaiming any and all public rights, title and interest in such closed portion of such sanitary sewer line. Being an existing easement of unknown width situated in the Edmond Quirk Survey, Abstract 35, San Augustine County, Texas and being a part of called 2.894 acre tract described as Tract 1 and part of a called 2.745 acre tract described as Tract 2 in a deed from Tom Burrus Blount, Jr. and wife Patricia Blount to Rudisill Properties, LLC, dated September 25, 2012 and recorded in Volume 256, Page 240, of the Official Records of San Augustine County, Texas. Alderman Mike Malone offered the motion to approve the Sanitary Sewer Line Abandonment and Quitclaim Ordinance. Alderman Joe Verhalen seconded the motion.
