## 3. <u>Discussion and Action If Any On Disposition Of Crews For Restoration Of City's Power Grid</u> <u>After Tornado Damages</u>

City Manager John Camp discussed the above item with the council. We currently have crews from the City of Hemphill, Jasper-Newton Co-op, RES – Bynum, TX, and BA Electrical – Trout, La.. The approximate cost per day for RES is \$35,000.00, this does not include hotels and meals. There is a total of 52 crews which is \$113,750.00 total cost per day maximum. On Monday we hope to have about 89% of customers restored and we can release some of the crews. Deep East Texas Electric Co-op will provide crews to help out free charge for two days. This will help to reduce the number of crews already on hand. The total cost for contractors is approximately \$468,125.00. FEMA will not provide funding for this incident because it does not fall within the threshold of \$36,000,000.00 across the state. There was no action taken on this item.
