3. <u>Discussion and Action If Any On Emergency Procedures Due To Inclement Weather The Week Of February 15, 2021 Discussion and Action If Any On Emergency Procedures Due To Inclement Weather The Week Of February 15, 2021</u>

City Manager John Camp discussed the above item with the Council. He reported that we experienced a water shortage in town due to elements of the production system freezing causing water to not be pumped to the towers. The crew is working and repairing leaks to the system. The system is coming back online and recharging. He does not know how long this will take. We are also experiencing electrical outages due to ice accumulation on the lines. The City's crew is working to restore services that they can bring back up in a short order. Mr. Camp asked the Council for permission to bring in contractors to help speed up the rest of the work needed to restore electrical services. He estimates we will need 3 crews for approximately 6 days. Alderman Marcus Hafford offered the motion to approve bringing in contractors to help with the restoration of electrical services to the City. Alderwoman Pamela Teel seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were Alderman Hafford, Alderwoman Teel, Alderman Stacy Watts, Alderman Steven Standley, and Alderman Dan Fussell. Motion carried.
