- The information regarding the gifting of the Pink House by the city to Care and Share has been received and completed by Attorney Wade Flasowski and we are ready to proceed.

This is a non-competitive grant issued by the General Land Office (GLO) distributing unreleased Harvey funds through DETCOG. It will be approximately \$1.6 million in funds. The Administrator will advise on how best to use these funds.
