The Angelina County & Cities Health District (COVID-19) confirmed the first positive COVID-19 case of a San Augustine County resident today.

As with anyone exposed to a Positive COVID-19 case, the Angelina County & Cities Health District is advising those directly exposed to self-quarantine and monitor themselves for flulike symptoms as recommended by the CDC.
