The project is intended to improve a critical hurricane evacuation route, improve safety by accommodating projected traffic and freight growth, and improve access to and from the ports in Beaumont, Port Arthur and Orange.

Proposed Improvements: The approximately 6.7-mile proposed project would widen the existing roadway from two lanes to a four-lane rural divided highway (median-separated). This roadway segment would also tie into a similar roadway configuration at the intersection of the southern project limit, RE 255 in Jasper County.

About Proposed US 96 Improvements:

Location: US 96 from Recreational Road (RE) 255 to Loop 149 in Jasper and Sabine Counties, Texas

Purpose: Improve a critical hurricane evacuation route, improve safety by accommodating projected traffic and freight growth, and improve access to and from the ports in Beaumont, Port Arthur and Orange.
